July 7th, 2026

On Tuesday July 7th, 2026 in the Meeting Room at the Floyd Mitchell Chickasaw Landfill at 5:30 p.m. the regular meeting of the Executive Board of the Floyd Mitchell Chickasaw Solid Waste Management Agency was held in person and by Zoom.

Chairman Scott Cerwinski, was in the chair. Executive Board members Jerry Joerger, Jerry Engelhardt, Keith Horgen, and Steve Geerts were in the Boardroom. Present by Zoom: Sydney Hartogh. Absent: Representative from Osage, Dave Swenumson and Boyd Campbell.

Employees Present: Christian Fox, Director.

Guests Present: None

A motion was made by Geerts, second by Horgen to approve the agenda as presented. All members present voting aye, motion carried.

A motion was made by Geerts, second by Joerger to approve the consent agenda and the minutes from the June 2026 Executive Board Meeting, and Summary List of Bills for June 2026 as presented. All members present voting aye, motion carried.

Financial Report- Joerger presented the Financial Report. Joerger stated that we were about $\frac{3}{4}$ through the budget at this time and everything looks good. He also stated that the interest rates on investments were all around 4% and the next CD to mature would be in August. After some discussion, a motion was made by Engelhardt and second by Geerts to approve the Financial Report. All members present voting aye, motion carried.

Discussion/Decision price change on tires- Fox stated that the tire disposal costs had been continuously increasing and there was also now a new charge for tires with rims. He also stated that the Landfill does not make any money on tire recycling. He stated that he spoke with local tire businesses and the common price charge per tire is \$8. After some discussion, a motion was made by Horgen and second by Engelhardt to increase car/truck tires to \$8 and car/truck tires with rims to \$10 effective October 1st. All members present voting aye, motion carried.

There being no further items requiring board action, the meeting was adjourned at 5:50 p.m. with a motion by Keith Horgen and second by Jerry Engelhardt. All members present voting aye, motion carried.
